

PRRT NOW DELIVERING THE PEARSON BTEC LEVEL 3 AWARD IN EDUCATION AND TRAINING

The Level 3 Award in Education and Training is to be delivered by PRRT from April 2019. This course is an introductory teaching qualification. Clients will be introduced to the necessary skills and knowledge required to prepare, plan, deliver and evaluate basic teaching and learning sessions.

The L3 EAT is suitable for clients experienced in delivering training, it also appeals to clients with no training experience aspiring to find employment in this sector.

TOPICS

This Level 3 qualification is accredited through Pearson BTEC, the course focuses on the following units, all units are explored in the classroom environment, through personal research and additional reading:

- Understanding Roles, Responsibilities and Relationships in Education and Training
- Understanding the Principles and Practices of Assessment
- Understanding and Using Inclusive Teaching and Learning Approaches in Education and Training

ASSESSMENT

All assessments are based on demonstrating knowledge, understanding and the application of learning. All clients taking this course are expected to plan, deliver and evaluate a micro- teaching session. This is in addition to the completion of written work/workbooks.

Successful completion of this course results in the following outcomes

- Development of knowledge related to teaching and learning
- Development of skills in teaching and learning
- Achievement of a nationally recognised L3 qualification

DELIVERY

The L3 EAT is delivered over a period of 5 days of 1 day per week at the PRRT Maryfield site. The course is available to eligible clients at a set cost. The course is open to others to include non-eligible clients, family members and employees of the DOJ at full cost.
